Being a By-Law to Amend City of North Bay Procedural By-Law 2019-80

WHEREAS section 238 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, as amended, provides that every municipality shall pass a Procedure By-Law for governing the calling, place and proceeding of meetings;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of North Bay has enacted Procedural By-Law 2019-80, as amended;

AND WHEREAS on July 21, 2020, the Province of Ontario enacted Bill 197, *COVID-19 Economic Recovery Act*, 2020, an Act to amend various statutes in response to COVID-19 and to enact, amend and repeal various statues;

AND WHEREAS Council passed Resolution 2021-241 on the 15th day of June, 2021, to amend the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law 2019-80, as amended, to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until December 31, 2021 and suspend the Notice Provision as set out in section 33 of the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law 2019-80, as amended.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That City of North Bay By-Law 2020-80, being a By-Law to amend City of North Bay Procedural By-Law 2019-80 be revoked.
- 2. That City of North Bay By-Law 2020-64, being a By-Law to amend City of North Bay Procedural By-Law 2019-80 be amended by deleting section 4 and inserting the following in lieu thereof:
 - "4. This By-Law shall be in force and effect upon passing until December 31, 2021."
