Flight Safety training is coming to North Bay. Over the next few months the Royal Canadian Air Force will be transitioning to online flight safety training that will be conducted through Defence Learning Network – distance learning platform. Until such time, the Basic Flight Safety Course (BFSC) will be offered at 22 Wing for those who are interested in the program or for a

The BFSC is a prerequisite for the Flight Safety Investigator Course (FSIC) offered in Winnipeg by 1 Canadian Air Division Flight Safety. The BFSC teaches students how to manage a flight safety program and is a qualification that would appear on your Member Personal Record Résumé after successfully completing a three-day course. Courses should begin this summer with the intent to run at least 2 weeks a year. For more information on training opportunities, or more about the program in general, speak to one of your
