Background:

On July 21, 2020, Council passed Resolution 2020-219 to amend the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until December 31, 2020.

On November 10, 2020, Council passed Resolution 2020-340 to make a further amendment to the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until July 31, 2021.

Due to the uncertainty of the current pandemic it is being recommended that Council further amend its Procedural By-Law to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until December 31, 2021. If during this time it is determined that Council can safely participate in in-person meetings in the Council

may be resumed.
