Recommendation

That Council:

- authorize the City Clerk to amend the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until April 30, 2022;
- 2. suspend the Notice Provision as set out in Section 33 of the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law.

Background

On June 15, 2021, Council passed Resolution 2021-241 to make a further amendment to the City of North Bay's Procedural By-Law to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until December 31, 2021.

Due to the uncertainty of the current pandemic it is being recommended that Council further amend its Procedural By-Law to allow Members of Council and Members of Local Boards or Committees to participate electronically in meetings until April 30, 2022. If during this time it is determined that Council can safely participate in in-person meetings in the Council Chambers, the amendment can be rescinded and in-person Council Meetings may be resumed.
