File No.**Res.** 2021 - _____**Moved by Councillor:** _____**Seconded by Councillor:** _____

That:

1. the Chief Administrative Officer, City Solicitor and Chief Financial Officer, jointly, be delegated the authority to:
 - (i) dispose of any real or personal property of the municipality which has a value exceeding \$50,000 when it was acquired by the municipality; and
 - (ii) make expenditures or incur liabilities which exceed \$50,000;
2. this delegation of authority will only take effect and be limited to the “Lame Duck Period” of Council and shall expire on Tuesday, November 15, 2022;
3. notice of the exercise of any such authority shall be given to the Council at the meeting prior to the exercise of such authority; and
4. Council authorize the passing of a By-Law delegating authority to the Chief Administrative Officer, City Solicitor and Chief Financial Officer, jointly, in the event of a “Lame Duck Council”.
