Subject: Request for Quote 2022-06 Bulk Road Salt

Recommendation

That City Council approves the award of a contract to Compass Minerals Canada Corp., based on the unit rates specified in their bid for RFQ 2022-06 for the provision of bulk road salt, for a term of two years, with an option in favour of the City to extend the agreement for an additional term of up to one year.

Background

Road salt is required to maintain City roads and sidewalks during the winter season. Approximately 3,500 tonnes of salt is used on an annual basis. All material is inventoried based on estimated requirements and drawn upon, as required. The current contract for bulk road salt is expiring.

Financial/Legal Implications

A formal bid request, which closed January 31, 2022, was administered by the Purchasing Department and was publically advertised in accordance with the City's Purchasing By-Law 2013-200. Two bids were evaluated by the Purchasing Manager and the Parts Technician. The evaluation considered company ability, experience and price. The results are as follows:

Ranking	Company	Bid Price
1	Compass Minerals Canada Corp.	\$777,035.00
2	Windsor Salt Ltd.	\$1,002,330.00

The bid price of \$777,035.00 (plus HST) from Compass Minerals Canada Corp. represents a total cost over the initial two year term based on the estimated quantities specified in the RFQ. Under the terms of the contract, the City will pay the unit rate specified and is not bound to any specific quantities. The quote from Compass Minerals Canada Corp. was the lowest bid and provides the best overall value to the City. Their bid is considered fair and reasonable.

The actual quantity and value of the commodity requested will vary based on operational requirements. Funding for road salt provided under this contract is managed within the operating budget of the Roads Department.

Sufficient funding will continue to be requested in future years.

Options Analysis

- Option 1: That City Council approves the award of a contract to Compass Minerals Canada Corp., based on the unit rates specified in their bid for RFQ 2022-06 for the provision of bulk road salt, for a term of two years, with an option in favour of the City to extend the agreement for an additional term of up to one year.
- Option 2: Do not award a contract. This option is not recommended because salt is necessary in maintaining safe roads and sidewalks during the winter season.

That City Council approves the award of a contract to Compass Minerals Canada Corp., based on the unit rates specified in their bid for RFQ 2022-06 for the provision of bulk road salt, for a term of two years, with an option in favour of the City to extend the agreement for an additional term of up to one year.
