Background

On March 22nd, 2022 North Bay City Council passed the Clean Yards By-law No. 2022-28 and repealed the Clean Yards By-law No. 2011-185. As a result of passing a new by-law, the existing set fine schedule for By-law 2011-185 is no longer valid. A new set fine schedule is proposed for By-law No. 2022-28 and a Council Resolution is required in order to submit the set fine schedule to the Ministry of the Attorney General for their approval.

Financial/Legal Implications

A new set fine schedule will allow for fines to be issued to an offender without the requirement for a court appearance, which reduces costs and time for enforcement and the Provincial Offences Office.
