Therefore Be It Resolved that The Council of the City of North Bay recognize Nipissing First Nation heritage as an important part of our community's history rename Marathon Beach as "Shaabgiizhig Jiigbiik" in Ojibway, and also to be known as "Shabogesic Beach".

And Further Be It Resolved that a plaque be constructed, in consultation with Nipissing First Nation, on the beach to share that history.
