Being a By-Law to Amend By-Law 2019-07 to Authorize User Fees For City Departments (Schedule "A")

And Whereas notice of the public meeting was published pursuant to City of North Bay Notice By-Law 2020-79 section 2(b) on the City of North Bay's Website on June 23, 2022;

And Whereas a Public Meeting under the Municipal Act in the matter of the user fees charged by various City Departments was held on the 12th day of July, 2022;

And Whereas Council passed Community Services Committee Report No. 2022-18 at its Regular Meeting held Tuesday, August 9, 2022 to authorize an amendment to the By-Law for User Fees charged by various City Departments.

Now Therefore the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay does hereby enact as follows:

- 1. That Schedule "A", Building Department, to By-Law No. 2019-07 to Authorize User Fees for Various City Departments be deleted and the attached Schedule "A" be inserted in lieu thereof.
- 2. This By-Law shall come into force and effect the day it is passed.
