#### Recommendation

That council permit the following 3 professional fireworks displays:

- 1) Nov 25, 2022, North Bay Downtown DIA old fashion Christmas walk and tree lighting event.
- 2) Dec 2, 2022, Canadore College Christmas Concert Event
- 3) Dec 31, 2022, City of North Bay Families First Event

#### **Background**

Council enacted by-law 2010-146, being a by-law to regulate the sale of Fireworks and for prohibiting the sale of Fireworks on certain days during the year. In By-law 2010-146 the use of fireworks is only permitted 3 times a year, any other fireworks display must be authorized by a resolution of Council.

Fire and Emergency Services has received 3 requests to permit fireworks display on days not authorized in the by-law.

The first request is to permit a pyrotechnic display on Nov 25, 2022, in the field behind the North Bay Museum. This display is being managed by a professional fireworks company contracted by The Downton North Bay DIA. This fireworks display is part of Downtown North Bay DIA old fashion Christmas walk and tree lighting event.

The second request is a pyrotechnic display on Dec 2, 2022, at Canadore College 60 Commerce Crt. This display is being managed by a professional fireworks company contracted by Canadore College. This fireworks display is part of Canadore's Christmas Concert Event.

The third request is a pyrotechnic display on Dec 31, 2022, at Thompson Park. This display is being managed by a professional fireworks company contracted by the City of North Bay. This fireworks display is part of the City of North Bay's Families First New Year's Eve celebration.

The professional fireworks company is Dream Catcher Fireworks. This company has done several displays in North Bay and always done a safe and professional job. All paperwork, insurance and legislated request are in order.

Fire and Emergency Services has reviewed all requests for safety.
