The user fees charged by the Transit Department for the use of City Transit shall be as follows:

Children 12 and under – Up to three children 12 years of age and under are able to travel for free with a paying parent(s) or guardian(s) during all service hours.

Families – Up to three children under the age of 16 can ride free with their fare paying parent(s) or guardian(s): Weekdays Monday to Thursday from 5:00p.m. until the end of day service and weekends beginning February at 5:00pm through to the end of day service Sunday.

Attendant Card – A person who requires an attendant may purchase an “Attendant Photo I.D. Card (\$10.00) which enables the attendant to ride free.

C.N.I.B. – A person registered with the “Canadian National Institute for the Blind”. When the card is presented the individual rides free.

Bus passes require a transit photo ID card, which are \$10.00.

* The above noted rates are consistent with the rates in effect in 2022. Transit rates were previously posted on the City’s website; however, it recommended that the rates be incorporated in the City’s user fee by-law.
