That Council authorize an amendment to City of North Bay By-Law 2018-53, being a By-Law to Regulate the Administration of Building Permits, as amended, as set out in Report to Council CSBU 2023-13 by Beverley Hillier dated January 16, 2023.	
<b>Background</b> Council adopted By-law 2018-53 on August 14, 2018. The <i>Building Code Act</i> , 1992, SO 1992, c 23 requires that Council appoint the Chief Building Official and various inspectors as necessary to regulate and enforce the provisions of the Act.	
An amendment to Building By-law 2018-53 is required because of staff changes within the department. Will Williamson is no longer working for the City and has been replaced by Mike Pilon. In addition, Brad Grasser, who joined the department as a Jr. Plan Examiner has recently become qualified as a Building Inspector. The amendment to the Building By-law reflects these staffing changes.
