And Whereas this Bill will allow municipalities to direct the Integrity Commissioner to apply to the court to vacate a member's seat for failing to comply with the municipality's workplace violence and harassment policies by amending the Municipal Act, 2001 and the City of Toronto Act, 2006.
Therefore be it Resolved that the City of North Bay send a copy of this motion in support of endorsing the Stopping Harassment and Abuse by Local Leaders Act to Premier Ford, MPP Victor Fedeli, the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO).
