Recommendation

Background

On December 3, 2007, Council adopted By-Law No. 2007-228, being a by-law to adopt the Delegation of Powers and Duties Policy. The purpose of the policy is to set out the scope of the powers and duties which Council may delegate its legislative and administrative authority and to establish principles governing those delegations.

On January 16, 2024, Council passed Resolution 2024-02 authorizing amendments to the City of North Bay Purchasing By-Law 2013-200. In order to optimize the efficiency of the Purchasing By-Law, changes to the Delegation By-Law are recommended as follows:

- 31. <u>Execution of Contracts awarded in accordance with Purchasing By-Law 2013-200, as amended.</u>
- 31.1 The Chief Administrative Officer and City Clerk be delegated the authority to execute contracts that have been awarded in accordance with Purchasing By-Law 2013-200, as amended, that are satisfactory in technical content to the responsible

Business Unit Lead, in financial content to the Chief Financial and in form satisfactory to the City Solicitor.
