#### Recommendation

That Council permit:

- 1. the City of North Bay Arenas and Events division to have a pyrotechnic (fireworks) display to celebrate New Years Eve on December 31, 2024, at Thomson Park; and
- 2. Canadore College to have a pyrotechnic (fireworks) display on December 19, 2024, as part of their Christmas celebrations at the main campus at 100 College Drive.

#### **Background**

Council enacted By-Law 2010-146, being a By-Law to Regulate the Sale of Fireworks and for Prohibiting the Sale of Fireworks on certain days during the year. In By-Law 2010-146 the use of fireworks is only permitted three (3) times a year, any other fireworks display must be authorized by a Resolution of Council.

Fire and Emergency Services has received two (2) requests to permit pyrotechnic (fireworks) displays on a day not authorized in the By-Law.

The first request is to permit a pyrotechnic display on December 19<sup>th</sup> at Canadore College's main campus. This display is being managed by a professional fireworks company contracted by Canadore College.

The second request is to permit the City of North Bay's Annual New Years Eve fireworks on December 31<sup>st</sup> at Thomson Park. This event is also being managed by a professional fireworks company.

Fire and Emergency Services has reviewed each request for safety and compliance with the by-law.
