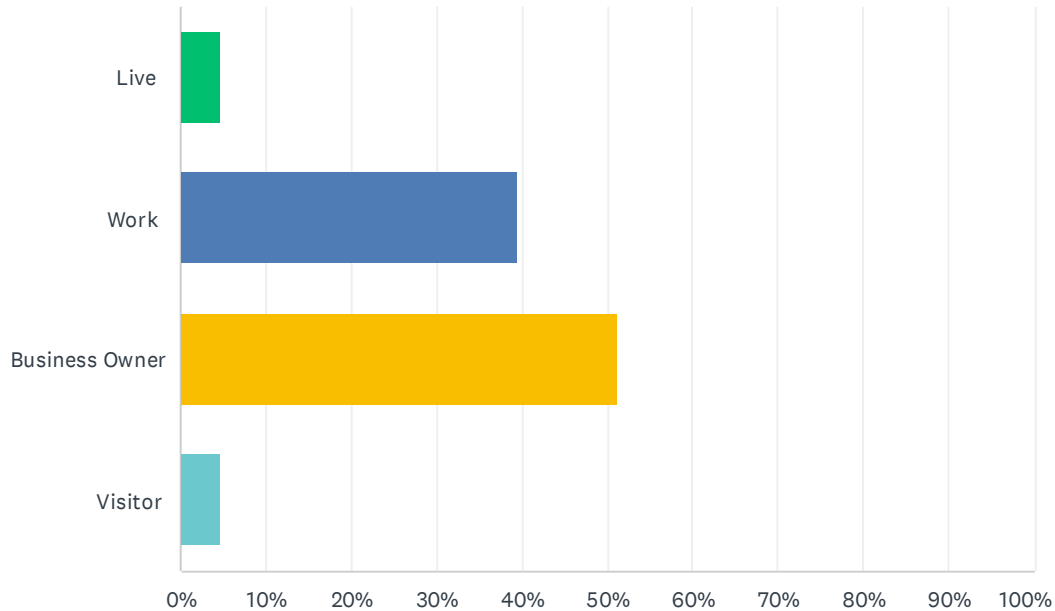

Q1 What best describes your relationship to the downtown and waterfront areas of North Bay?

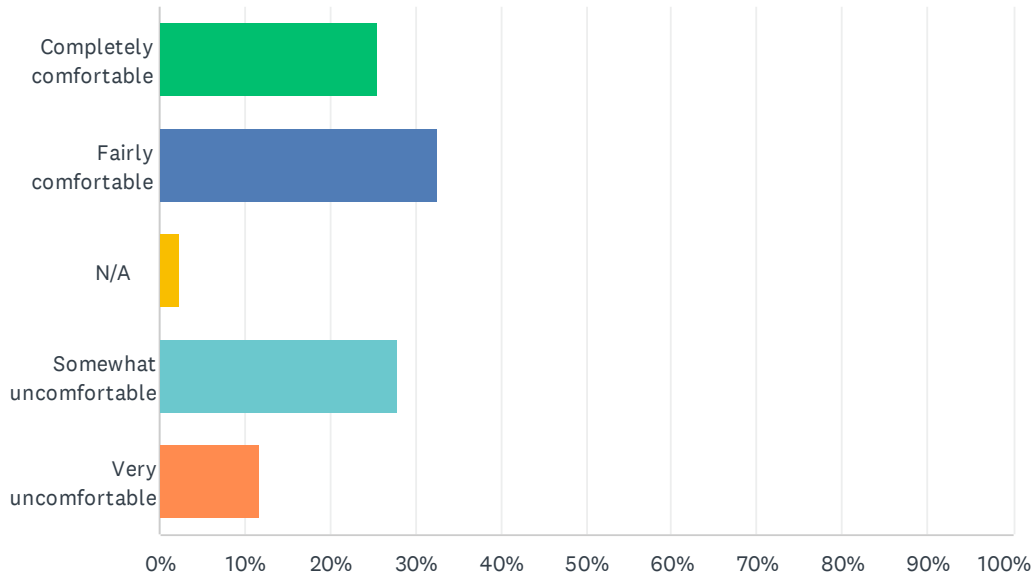

Q2 What is your level of comfort in the Downtown and waterfront 7am-2pm?

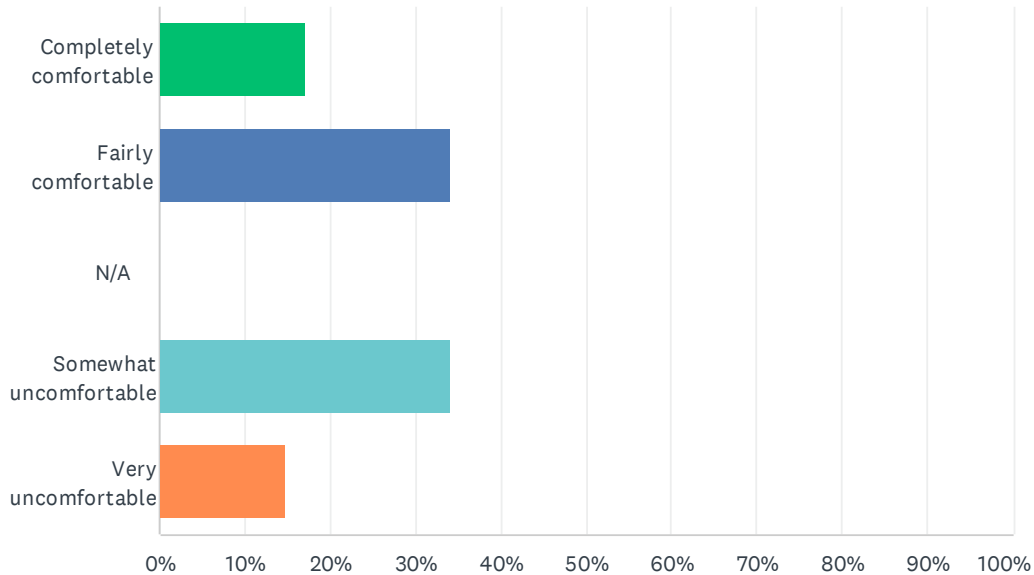

Q3 What is your level of comfort in the Downtown and waterfront 2pm-9pm?

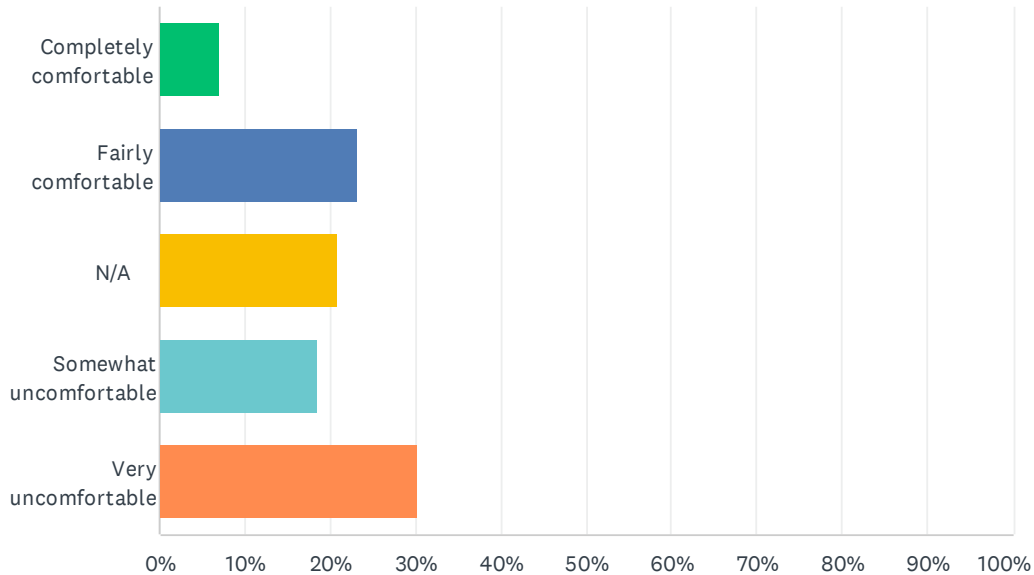

Q4 What is your level of comfort in the Downtown and waterfront 9pm-12am?

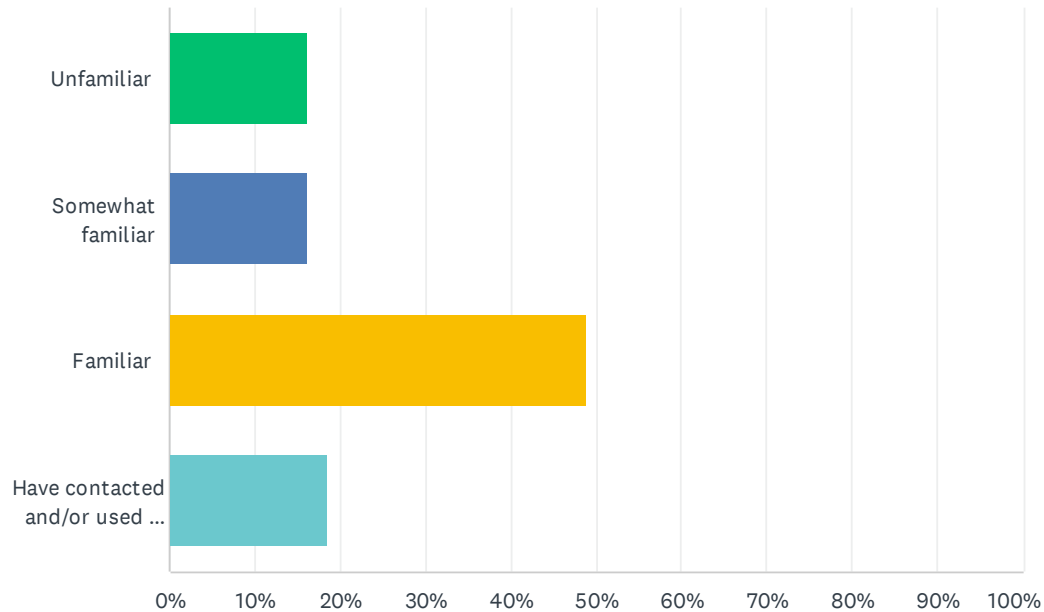

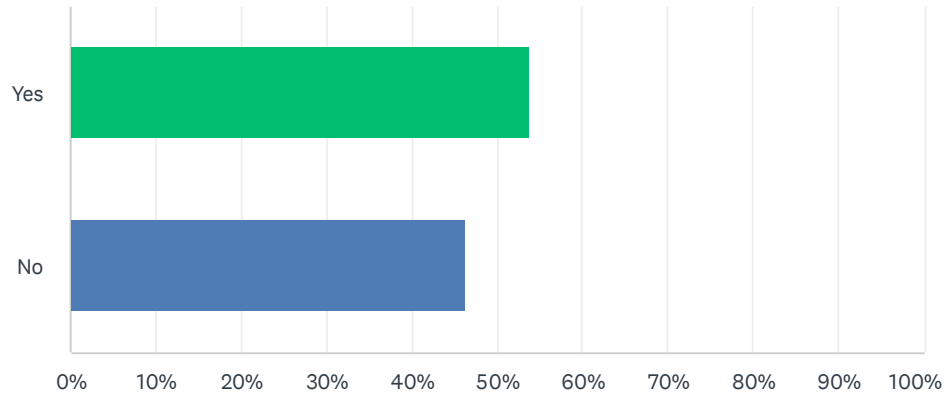

Q6 Has the POST Pilot launched in July changed your level of comfort in the downtown and waterfront?

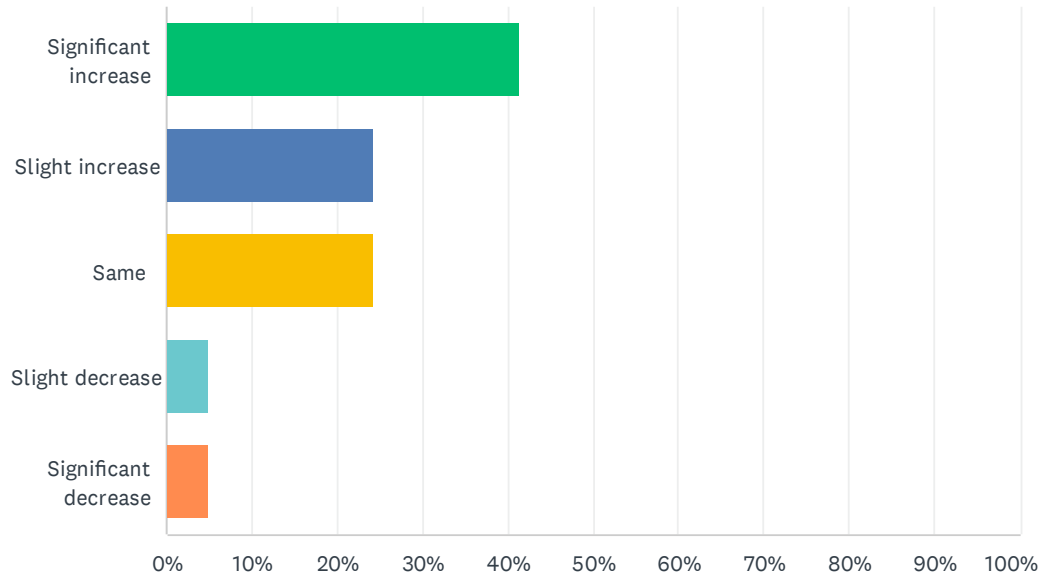

Q7 How would you describe Security/Outreach presence/visibility in the downtown in the last 2 years?

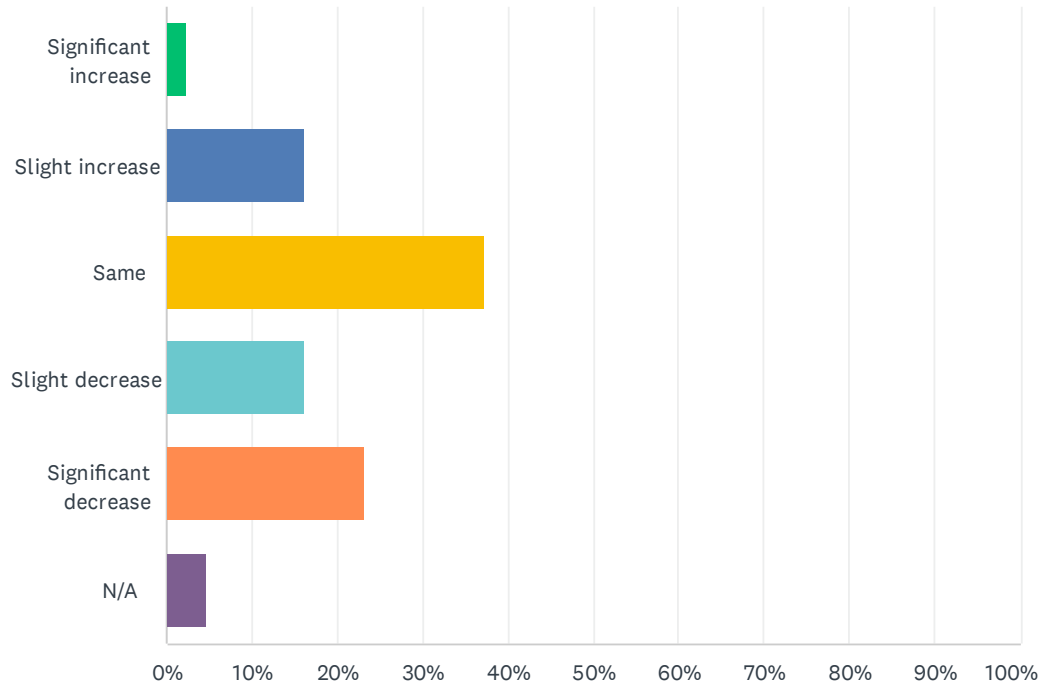

Q8 How would you best describe Police presence/visibility in the downtown over the last 2 years?

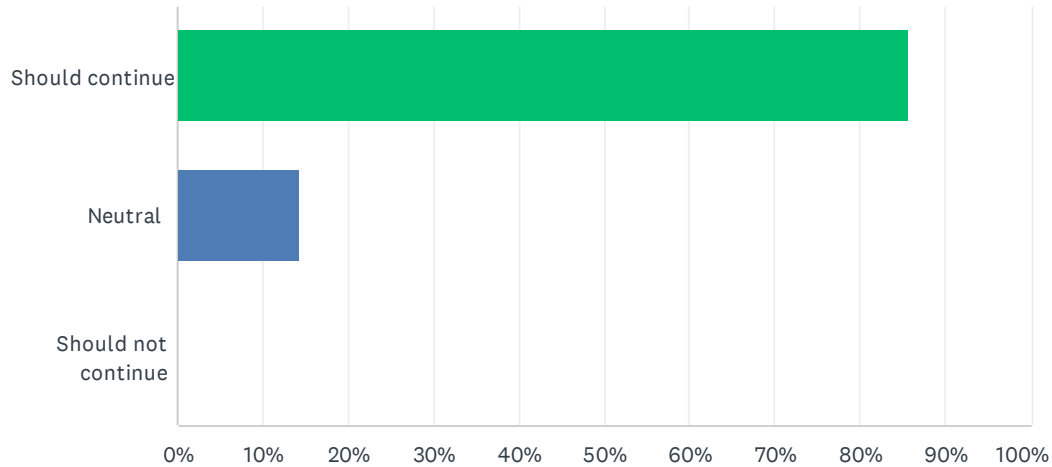
